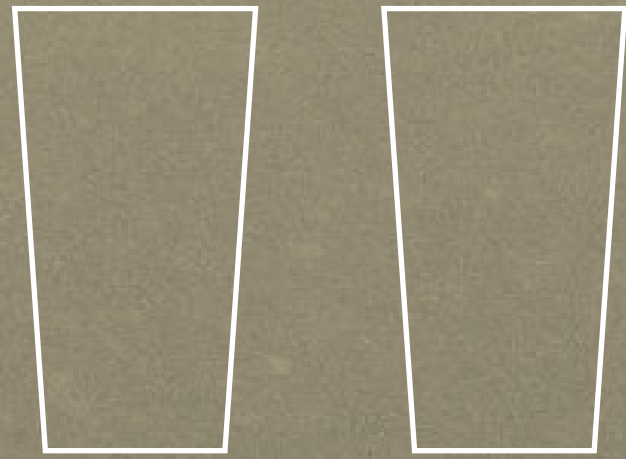

“Mommy, who decides which Soldiers are going to deploy to war?”

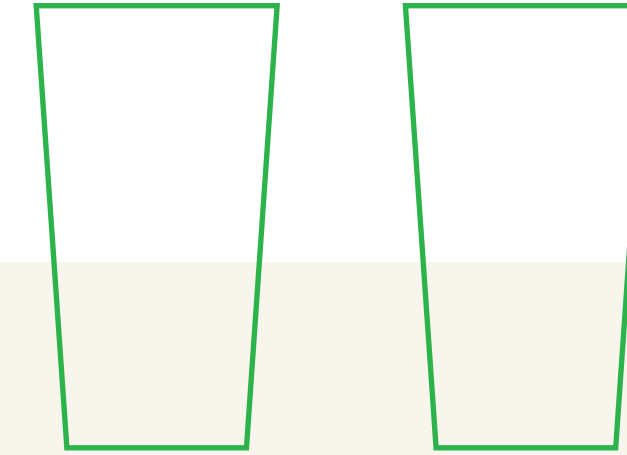
“Will daddy have to deploy soon?”

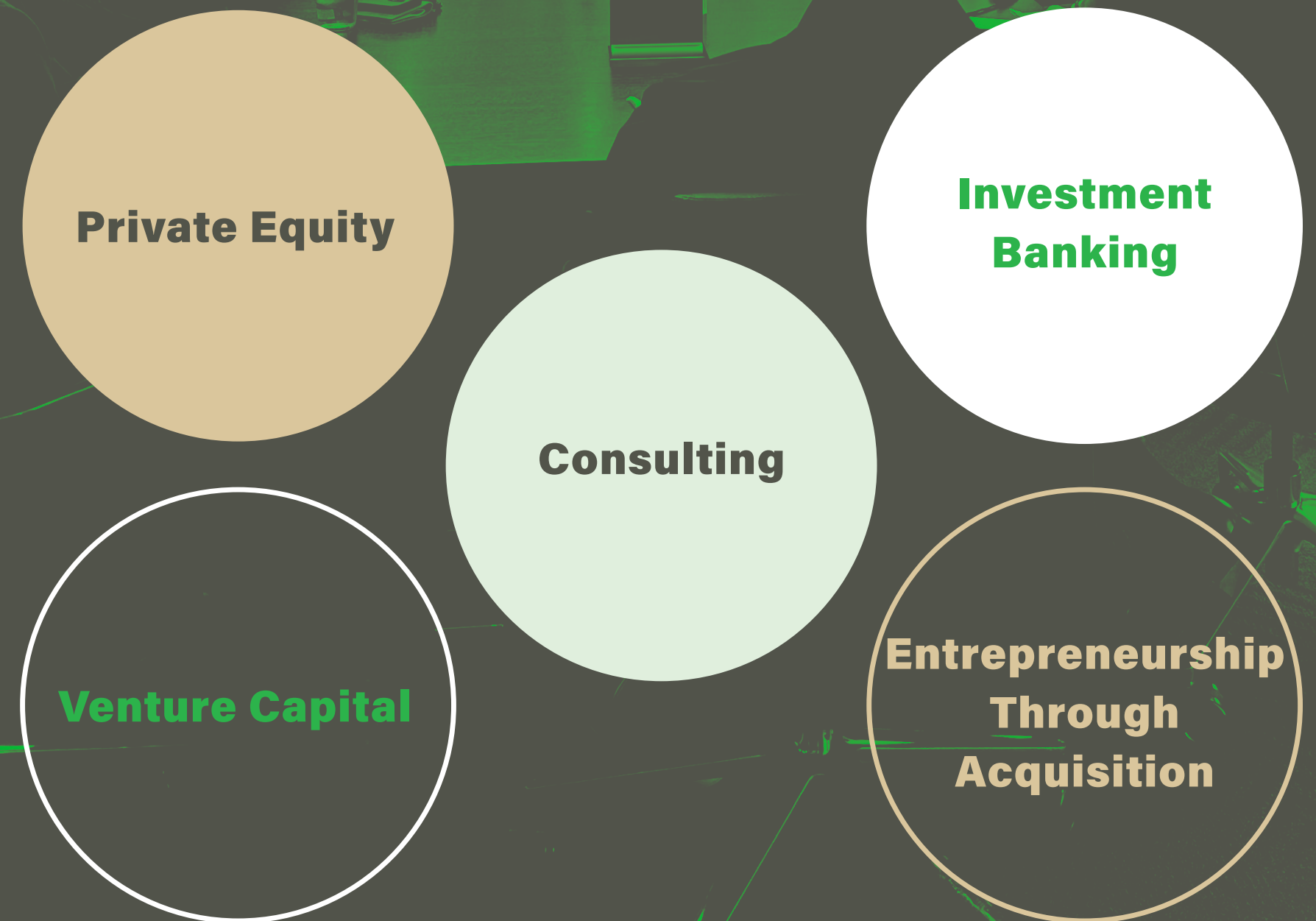

51 Vets operates with a clear priority: maximize resources that directly support member outcomes.

In 2025, we continued improving how donor support translates into program impact. This shift reflects our commitment to efficiency and stewardship while scaling impact.

We invested in a Donor CRM, we established a Development Strategy, and we built an internal member database and work-flow tool to significantly reduce labor hours required to support member requests.

Funding enables the key programmatic events we execute to educate our members on these industries, place them close to professionals, companies, and opportunities, and to personally mentor them.

Much of the strength of 51 Vets comes from relational capital. Our network of mentors, professionals, and members enables opportunities to grow without requiring proportional increases in expenses.

As our community expands, the value of that network compounds.
